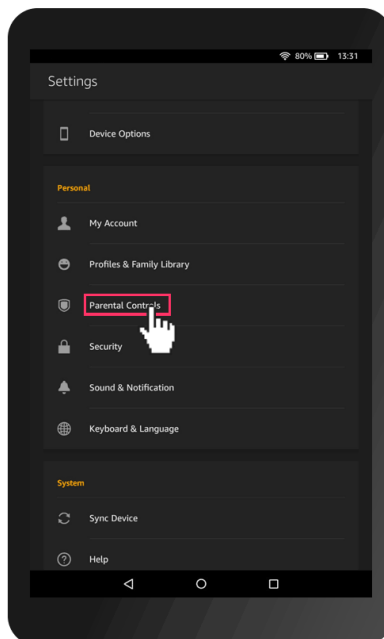

Swipe down from the top of the screen and then tap Settings. Tap Parental Controls.

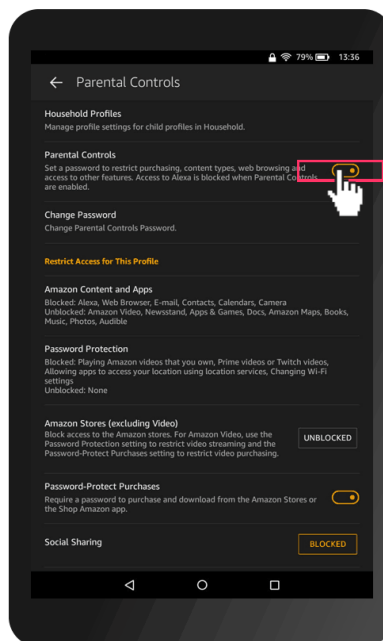

Tap On next to Parental Controls.

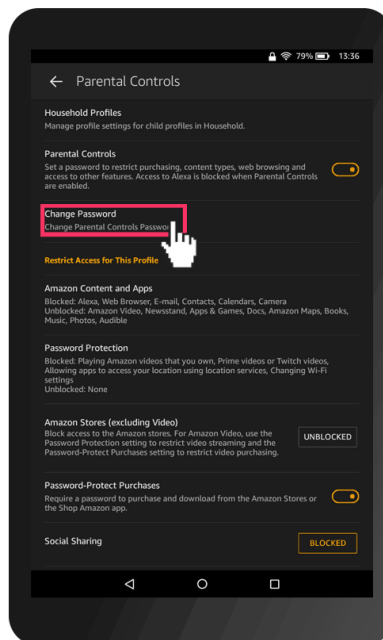

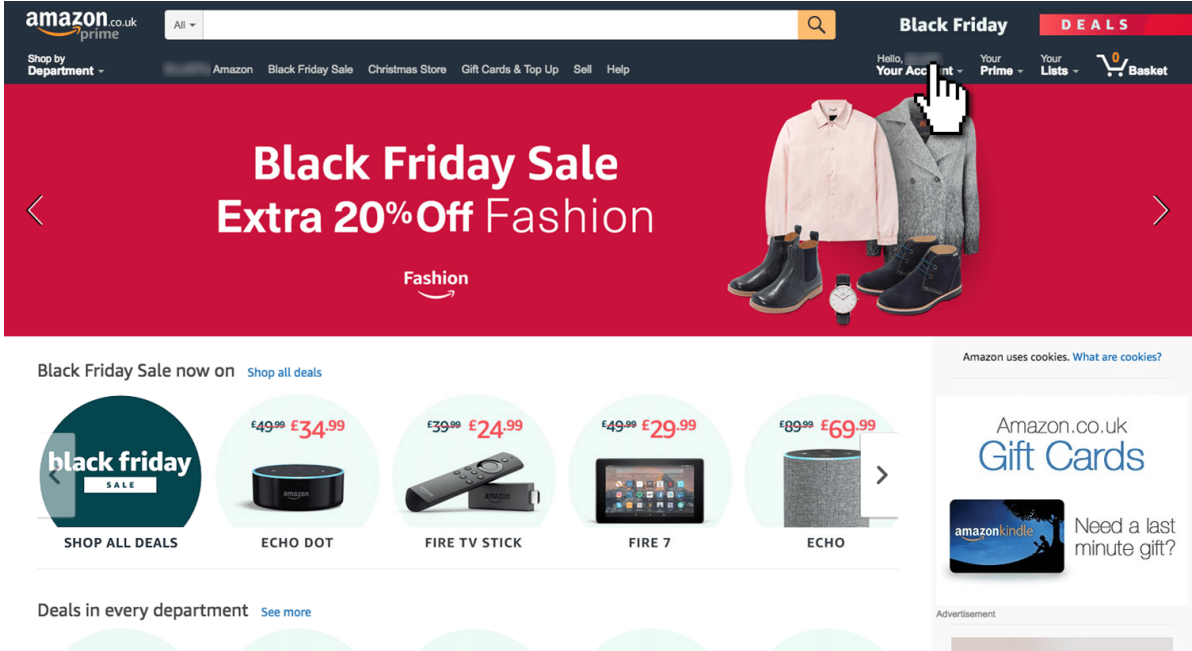
With Parental Controls turned on, enter a password, confirm your password and then tap Submit.

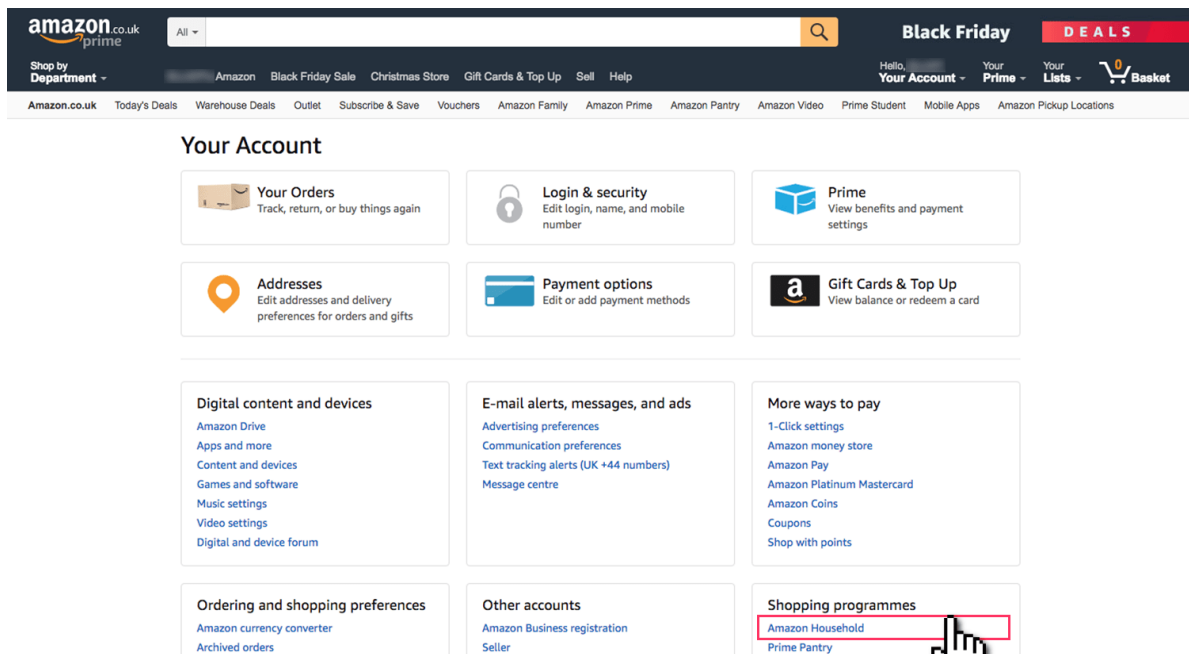

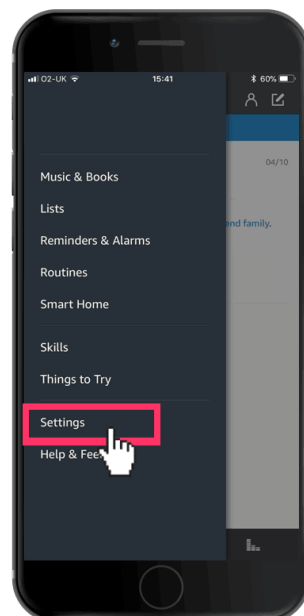

Add a pin/disable voice purchasing to prevent unauthorised purchases Open the Alexa App or echo.amazon.com on your smartphone and tap the menu icon.

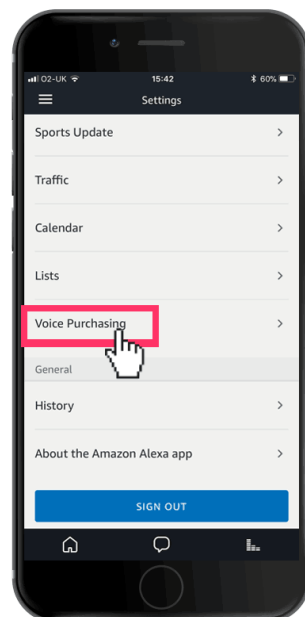
